Museum of Culture and Organs, Valley

The castle in the town of Valley is one of the oldest in the nation. Over the course of its long and colourful history, the building served as a courthouse for around 700 years. It also served as the residence of author, Michael Ende for six years. In 2001, a wooden hall built in 1923 according to the architect, Friedrich Zollinger was saved from destruction and moved to the castle grounds. Meticulously restored, it now serves as a museum of culture and organs that can also be used to host events of all kinds. Covering around 150 sqm, Zollinger Hall is home to the largest pipe organ in the region.
